BACKGROUND

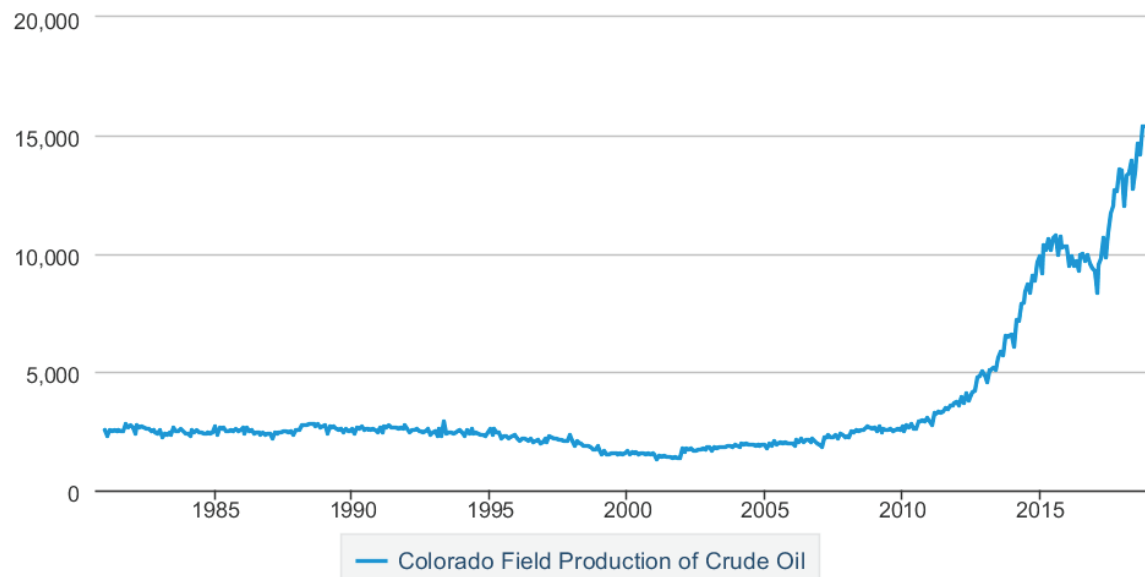
Colorado is currently ranked seventh in domestic oil production and sixth in natural gas production and has just more than 53,000 active wells. PESA Member Companies directly employ more than 3,700 individuals in Colorado with high-paying manufacturing and technical jobs.

QUICK FACTS

- Colorado's crude oil production has quadrupled since 2010, and the state holds about 4% of total U.S. crude oil reserves.
- Colorado is the fifth-largest natural gas-producing state, and 11 of the nation's 100 biggest natural gas fields are located here.
- The oil and natural gas industry supports 232,900 jobs in the state, and in 2015 contributed \$31.38 billion to the state's economy.
